Speaking 4 the Planet

Speaking 4 the Planet (S4P) is an Arts-based competition that focuses on sustainability issues. It promotes and recognises youth advocacy through Arts media, including speaking, writing, art, drama and video. Commencing in 2013, S4P has now operated in Australia, New Zealand, Thailand and Viet Nam. A recent Decade Evaluation report discusses the reach and the findings.

Viet Nam 2023 online competition

A national S4P competition will take place in Viet Nam in 2023. The title of the competition is **Go Wild! Protect Vietnam's Wildlife**. This topic invites youth across Viet Nam to express their views on a significant national issue – the protection of indigenous wildlife. The target audience will be students 12-18, with two age categories: junior (age 12-15), and senior (age 16-18). The competition will be conducted in English.

The competition categories are Speaking, Writing and Visual Arts. A support package will be produced and available for participants. It contains the judging criteria.

Participants will submit their entries online. The best from each category will be invited to present at a live online event where the winners and runners-up will be decided.

Judges will include specialists in each of the competition categories and a representatives from the competition partners or sponsors.

The S4P competition will be independently evaluated, and a brief report will be produced. It will include a financial report.

Competition partners are Save Vietnam's Wildlife, Sutherland Shire Environment Centre and Paddy Pallin.

Why this topic?

Much of Vietnam's wildlife is under threat from the pressures of development, human actions, and broader issues such as climate change. <u>Here, Mr Thai Nguyen, CEO of Save Vietnam's Wildlife and Patron of this 2023 S4P competition, says more about the importance of protecting wildlife in Viet Nam and invites young people to express their views.</u>

Why sponsor this competition?
